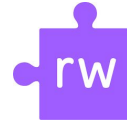


Read and Write for Google Chrome by TextHelp

- Chrome Extension
- This tool brings together several key assistive tech tools in one tool bar. Read & Write is accessible on the web and within Google Docs.
- Key features: Text-to-Speech, Prediction, Dictionary and Picture Dictionary, Simplify Page, Voice Note, Talk & Type, Screen Mask, Fluency tool, Audio Maker
- Cost: Teachers qualify for a free premium account. Premium features also available for individual or site subscription. (Basic features are free.)

- Create books containing text, photos, audio and video files.
- Share as a digital book, movie or pdf.
- Online tool is compatible with iPad app
- Cost for Chrome version: Teachers can have one free bookshelf to share with students online. Additional shelves available in premium version.
- Cost for iPad app: \$4.99

- Show what you know! Demonstrate how to do a math problem, how to code a word, or how something works.
- Online tool is compatible with iPad app
- Cost: Educational price is \$4.99 each with minimum of five users (or \$9.99/individual)

- Conduct research using online encyclopedias that are safe and age-appropriate.
 - Example: Britannica School contains leveled articles and engaging multimedia presentations with citation-maker
- Obtain password from your school or public library (passwords change quarterly)

Google Suite (Formerly Google Apps for Education)

- Productivity tools - whether you are working alone, collaborating with peers, or getting feedback from a teacher, Google Suite has the right tool!
 - Google Docs - Word processor
 - Google Slides - Slide presentations
 - Google Sheets - Spreadsheet / graph-making tool
 - Google Classroom - Paperless way for teachers to send and collect assignments
- Customize add-ons and extensions that are right for you
- Cost: Free

- Audio books featuring human voices
- VOICEtext books have highlighted text synced with narration
- Customize audio speed, text size and highlighting color
- Chrome Extension (also available as iPad and iPhone app)
- Cost: Requires annual membership fee; available to qualifying individuals

- Cost: Free - \$4.99 per year

- Cost: \$17 / year for individuals; site license available
